

Constitution of the Multi-Age Physical Education, Multi-Age Health Education, and Physical Activities and Sports Studies Majors and Minors

Article I – Name

The name of this organization will be: **Pi Epsilon Omega (PE Org)**

Article II – Purpose

1. Members shall demonstrate a wider interest in their profession by their membership and attendance in club activities
2. Member shall become more professionally minded through cooperation and identification with national, state, and local health physical education, and recreation professional associations.
3. The club will serve as a mentorship program in which upperclassmen will have opportunities to interact and provide personal aid to underclassmen.
4. The club aims to serve the community and university body through physical activity service projects.
5. The club will serve as a means of dispersing information through national conventions, special speakers, literature, and will promote professional and social cooperation among health, physical education, and sport studies, majors, minors, and faculty.
6. Members shall apply Christian principles of living through their involvement in professional activities.

Article III- Membership

Membership is open to all students pursuing a major or minor in multi-age Physical education, multi-age health education, physical activity and sport study, exercise science, coaching, sport ministry, and sport management
A fee will be established every year at the first meeting.

Article IV- Officers' Responsibilities and Requirements

The officers of the organization will be Presidents, Vice President, Secretary, Treasure, and a Representative from each class. All members with at least a 2.5 G.P.A. are eligible to be nominated for Secretary, Treasurer, and a Representative

from each class. All members with a 2.7 G.P.A. are eligible to be nominated for President and Vice-President.

Co-Presidents

1. Provide means to accomplish club objectives
2. Plan the meetings of executive board
3. Be supportive of other officers and members
4. Attend activities for which the club is responsible
5. Attend executive board meetings
6. Be willing to help with the planning of activities
7. Be a full time junior or senior student

Co-Vice Presidents

1. Assist the president in any way possible
2. Attend activities for which the club is responsible
3. Attend executive board meetings
4. Be willing to help with the planning activities
5. Take over president's responsibilities in his or her absence
6. Assume responsibility for devotions at club meetings

Secretary

1. Informing officers of meetings via email
2. Type of needed information
3. Keeping minutes at executive board meetings
4. Attend activities for which the club is responsible
5. Attend executive board meetings
6. Be willing to help with the planning of activities

Treasurer

1. Keep a record of income and expenditures
2. Organize fundraisers
3. Keep a record of members participation at service projects for special discounts on activities
4. Attend activities for which the club is responsible
5. Attend executive board meetings
6. Be willing to help with the planning of activities

Class Representatives

1. Attend activities for which the club is responsible
2. Attend executive board meetings
3. Be willing to help with the planning of activities
4. Organize meetings with members from their class twice a semester to discuss issues that pertain specifically to the class
4. Present information discussed at class meetings to the executive board

Article V- Officer Appointments

Former officers and advisors will elect members to take office the following year. The criteria for selection will include: previous club activity, professional activity, academic standing, spiritual maturity, and advisor's approval.

Appointment to office will occur by the beginning of April. The newly appointed officers will work with the present officers for the remainder of the semester.

Article VI – Meetings

1. The executive board shall consist of the officers and the advisor of the organization
2. The executive board will meet every other week
3. The members and executive board will convene once a month
4. In case of a vacancy of office, a new officer will be appointed by the remainder of the executive board. If the vacancy is in the presidency the vice president will assume the president's responsibilities. The office of vice president will be filled.
5. If an officer fails to fulfill his or her duty as stated in the constitution, he or she may be impeached by the executive board. At such a time, a special executive board meeting will be called to decide upon the validity of the complaint before the situation is open to the club.
