### Who:

Boys in grades 7–12

### What:

Cedarville soccer academy is committed to a high level of technical and tactical learning for all campers. Daily sessions are designed with an emphasis on teaching fundamental skills, tactical awareness, leadership, and Christian principles. Modeled after its own style of play, Cedarville soccer academy teaches and challenges campers to play a very quick, attacking, possession-oriented way of playing the game. Through technical training, small-sided games, competition, and larger game settings, players are continually pushed to grow both as players and individuals. Time is also set aside each day to consider Christian principles and their application to daily living.

### Schedule:

Check in between 1–3 p.m. on Sunday in the Doden Field House. The first camp session begins at 3:30 p.m. Camp concludes at 12 p.m. on Thursday.

### Location:

Cedarville University, Cedarville, Ohio

- Practices are held in Cedarville's outstanding training and match facilities, including the lighted stadium soccer complex and multiple practice fields.

- Students are housed according to age category in air-conditioned residence halls on campus with counselor supervision. Campers should bring their own bedding and towels.

### Cost:

\$345 per resident camper

\$250 per commuter

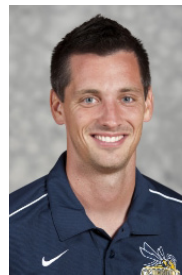
Fee includes a T-shirt, room and board for a resident camper, and lunch and supper for a commuter.

Campers are responsible for lost keys (\$50) and any room damage.

The following discounts are available and may be combined:

- Two or more campers from the same household: \$10 per camper
- Early registration (before June 17): \$10 per camper
- Campers attending more than one CU sports camp: \$10 per camper
- Alumni children: \$10 per camper
- Sibling of current CU student: \$10 per camper
- Cedarville faculty and staff children: \$50 per camper
- Teams with seven or more players attending: \$15 per camper (Registrations must be mailed together.)

## CAMP DIRECTOR: TODD BEALL



Todd Beall has completed two seasons as the head men's soccer coach at Cedarville University. Beall's initial campaign in 2010 was a successful one. He guided his alma mater to a 13-9 record, the NCCAA Midwest Region championship, and a runner-up showing at the NCCAA National Tournament. Beall earned NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year honors, and two of his players were NCCAA All-American First Team selections. The 2011 season was filled with more success for Coach Beall and the Yellow Jackets. The team finished with a record of 14-6-3, a second consecutive NCCAA Midwest Region title and a third-place spot at the NCCAA National Tournament. Beall was honored for the second straight year as NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year. Two more Yellow Jacket players were recognized as members of the NCCAA All-America First Team. A former Yellow Jacket and team captain, Todd Beall returned to his alma mater following a successful four-year run as head coach at Geneva College in Beaver Falls, Pennsylvania. Beall is the eighth head coach in the 49-year history of the CU men's soccer program.



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q:** What residence hall supervision is provided?  
**A:** Team coaches and camp staff will provide supervision in the residence halls. Camper/staff ratio is approximately ten to one.
- Q:** How many students are in each residence hall room?  
**A:** Two students per room
- Q:** Who receives the early registration discount?  
**A:** Campers who register three weeks prior to camp qualify for a discount of \$10 per player.
- Q:** What meals are provided?  
**A:** Resident campers receive three meals per day beginning with dinner on Sunday and ending with breakfast on Thursday. Commuter campers receive lunch and dinner Monday–Wednesday.
- Q:** Are campers busy all day?  
**A:** The schedule for camp is rigorous but includes time for relaxation and relationship-building. A typical day begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 9 p.m. See a sample schedule online.
- Q:** May campers bring electronic games, iPods, or other electronic devices?  
**A:** Students are discouraged from bringing electronic devices. The University is not responsible for lost, broken, or stolen items.
- Q:** May students leave camp for other summer sports activities?  
**A:** Yes, with written approval from the parent or guardian.
- Q:** May parents observe camp?  
**A:** Yes, parents are welcome to watch games. Schedules are available for reference at the start of camp.
- Q:** Should campers bring money?  
**A:** A camp bank will be available on registration day. All money should be put into the camp bank. A concession stand is provided each day for snacks.
