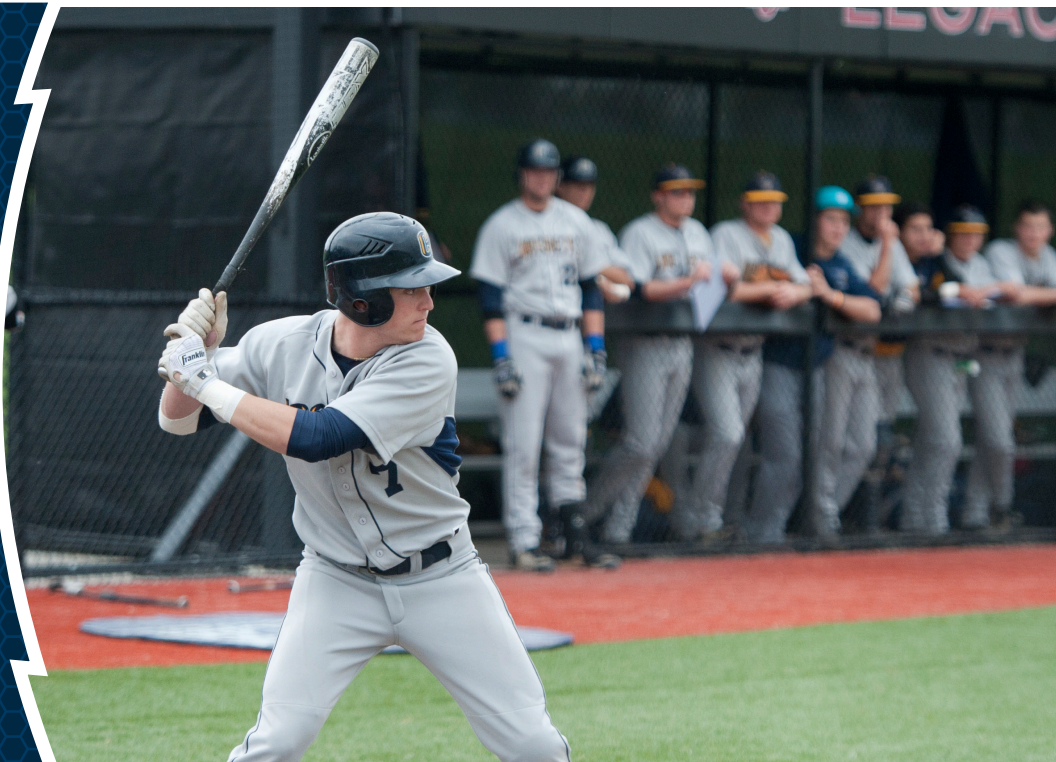

CAMP DIRECTOR: MIKE MANES



Mike Manes has been the head baseball coach at Cedarville University since 2008. He has guided the Yellow Jackets to their three winningest seasons in school history and two trips to the NCCAA National Tournament. Cedarville posted a 28-27 record in 2010 which provided the Jackets with their first back-to-back winning season in baseball in more than 30 years. They were also the NCCAA Midwest Region runner-up last spring. Manes was named the 2009 and 2011 NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year after leading Cedarville to its third region title. The Yellow Jackets won over 30 games for the second time and have broken the school record for wins in a year three of four seasons. His teams have won 116 games in just four years. He has had:

- 2 NCCAA Burbridge Unlimited Potential Player of the Year
- 3 NCCAA National All-Tournament Team players
- 6 NAIA Scholar-Athletes
- 9 NCCAA Scholar-Athletes
- 18 All-NCCAA Midwest Region players
- 9 All-American Mid-east Conference players
- 2 All-AMC Rawlings Gold Glove Team player
- 2 NCCAA Regional Player of the year
- 1 NCCAA Regional Pitcher of the year

Manes came to the Yellow Jackets following a four-year stay as head coach at Trinity International University near Chicago. He was able to turn the TIU program around after inheriting a team that won just four games in his first season in 2004 and the school had never qualified for the conference tournament. Manes then guided the Trojans to 85 victories over the next three seasons by winning 25, 28, and 32 games, respectively, which set school records for the most victories in a season each time. The 2006 squad put together TIU's first-ever winning season and the 2007 team finished 32-22. In his short tenure, Manes guided the Trojans to their first-ever conference tournament appearance, two NCCAA North Central Region championships, and TIU played in the NCCAA National Tournament in each of his last three seasons. He was tabbed the 2005 NCCAA North Central Region Coach of the Year.

Manes is actively involved in baseball administration. He is currently the NCCAA National Chair as well as the G-MAC baseball chair.

ASSISTANT COACH: BEN GALBREATH



Ben Galbreath coaches the Cedarville pitchers, and is in his first year as an assistant coach at Cedarville University. Galbreath has eight years of coaching experience combined with a playing career that included four varsity letters earned at Kent State University. He was a work-horse out of the bull pen for Kent State by becoming the career leader in appearances in Kent State history, and is ranked in the top 10 in Mid-American Conferences history for career appearances. Galbreath was a part of one MAC overall regular season champions and two MAC tournament champion teams. He pitched in two College World Series regional tournaments.
