## BOYS BASKETBALL CAMP

June 24–28, 2012

### Who:

Boys in grades 5–12

### What:

Basketball camp offers solid instruction in the fundamental skills and tactical strategies of the game of basketball. Competitions, drills, and one-on-one attention build individual skills and team performance. Time is also set aside each day to consider Christian principles and their application to daily living. Coach Pat Estopp serves as the camp director. He is assisted by the Cedarville coaching staff, current and former players, and qualified high school coaches.

### Schedule:

Check in between 4–5:30 p.m. on Sunday in the Doden Field House. The first camp session begins at 5:30 p.m. Camp concludes at 12 p.m. on Thursday.

### Location:

Cedarville University, Cedarville, Ohio

- Seven indoor, air-conditioned courts — four in the Doden Field House and three in the Callan Athletic Center
- Students are housed according to age category in air-conditioned residence halls on campus. Campers should bring their own bedding and towels.

### Cost:

\$320 per resident camper

\$225 per commuter

Fee includes basketball jersey, room and board for a resident camper, and lunch and supper for a commuter.

Campers are responsible for lost keys (\$50) and any room damage.

The following discounts are available for Boys Basketball Camp and may be combined:

- Two or more campers from the same household: \$10 per camper
- Early registration (before June 3): \$10 per camper
- Campers attending more than one CU sports camp: \$10 per camper
- Alumni children: \$10 per camper
- Sibling of current CU student: \$10 per camper
- Cedarville faculty and staff children: \$50 per camper
- Teams with seven or more players attending: \$15 per camper (Registrations must be mailed together.)

## CAMP DIRECTORS: PAT ESTOPP AND BRETT NEWMAN



Pat Estopp is in his fourth season as the head men's basketball coach at Cedarville University. He has guided his alma mater to 73 victories and three consecutive national tournament appearances. The Yellow Jackets finished strong again in 2010–11 winning eight of their last nine regular season games including the last five in a row. CU was ranked as high as 14th in the NAIA Division II poll; they finished at 20-13 giving Estopp his third straight 20-win season. Cedarville won 16 of its last 18 games in 2009–10 to finish 26-9 and 14-2 in the American Midwest Conference as the league runner-up. The Yellow Jackets, who were ranked as high as eighth in the national poll, later won the AMC Tournament and advanced to the second round of

the national tournament. Estopp's inaugural campaign at the helm was full of memorable accomplishments. He guided the Yellow Jackets to a 27-4 overall record and a share of the AMC title with a 12-1 league mark. Cedarville was ranked as high as number one in the country, finished in a tie for the number two spot in the final poll, and advanced to the national tournament. Estopp was voted the AMC Coach of the Year as well as the NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year.



Brett Newman joins the Yellow Jacket men's basketball coaching staff for the 2011–12 season. Newman has 18 years of coaching experience at multiple levels of basketball including professional minor leagues, NCAA Division II, U.S. military all-stars, junior college, and high school. He also possesses an extensive camp and clinic background. Newman's most recent head coaching position was during the 2009–10 season at Academic Magnet High School in Charleston, South Carolina. It is recognized as one of the top Gold Medal List schools by US News & World Report and is number one in the country among magnet schools—public schools that attract the most talented students

in a region. Newman's experience at the college level includes a stint as an assistant at Division II Florida Gulf Coast University. He also assisted in the JUCO ranks at Fullerton College and served as head coach of the Southwest Air Force All-Stars featuring a roster from NAIA, junior college, and college prep schools. Newman has been on the coaching staffs of the ABL New Mexico Roadrunners as well as the IBL New Mexico Slam. He has been an NABC Coaches Clinic Director and has worked at numerous camps throughout the country.



## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q:** What residence hall supervision is provided?  
**A:** Team coaches and camp staff will provide supervision in the residence halls. Camper/staff ratio is approximately eight to one.
- Q:** How many students are in each residence hall room?  
**A:** Two students per room
- Q:** What meals are provided?  
**A:** Resident campers receive three meals per day beginning with dinner on Sunday and ending with breakfast on Thursday. Commuter campers receive lunch and dinner Monday–Wednesday.
- Q:** May campers bring electronic games, iPods, or other electronic devices?  
**A:** Students are discouraged from bringing electronic devices. The University is not responsible for lost, broken, or stolen items.
- Q:** May students leave camp for other summer sports activities?  
**A:** Yes, with written approval from the parent or guardian.
- Q:** May parents observe camp?  
**A:** Yes, parents are welcome to watch games. Schedules are available for reference at the start of camp.
- Q:** Should campers bring money?  
**A:** A camp bank will be available on registration day. All money should be put into the camp bank. A concession stand is provided each day for snacks.
