

Reporting Suspicious Persons or Criminal Activity and other Emergencies

You may report suspicious persons, criminal activities, or other emergencies by dialing 999 on any campus phone (from an off-campus phone, dial 937-239-6491). These numbers ring into the Campus Safety & Security, 24-hour-a-day emergency phone. You may also dial 911.

A campus security officer will respond immediately to assist you, as well as local police, fire, or emergency medical services, if necessary. The responding officer(s) prepare and submit incident reports for administrative review. Please remember to **REPORT IT IMMEDIATELY** as it may be imperative to make timely reports to the campus community warning others of the situation! Campus Security will have difficulty responding to crime or providing immediate assistance to you if they don't know about it. This may include campus thefts, assaults, vandalism, breaking and entering, suspicious persons seen in and around campus residence halls and buildings, fires, alarms, gas odors, medical emergencies, etc.

You may report crimes or other incidents on a voluntary, confidential basis if necessary, however, confidentiality cannot always be guaranteed depending on the nature and circumstances of the incident reported. In addition to reporting these matters to Campus Safety & Security, students may also report them to the Dean of Students or Associate Deans of Student Life. Pastoral and professional counselors are encouraged to inform clients of voluntary, confidential crime reporting procedures.
