## Spotlight On: Christian Ministries

Cedarville University believes individual ministry involvement is a vital part of each student's education and spiritual growth. Because of this, Cedarville University dedicated a whole division of the school specifically for Christian Ministries. The division of Christian Ministries is made up of five departments led by Pastor Bob Rohm, Vice President of Christian Ministries.

The Community Ministries department directed by John Wambold offers a variety of ministries for student involvement on a weekly basis. These opportunities range from church ministries, evangelism and hospital ministry to special needs, elderly and youth ministry, and many more. Community Ministries also sends out several teams during Spring Break to minister around the country.

The Discipleship Ministries department is led by Mark Irving and focuses on fostering spiritual growth and life change through small groups and mentoring relationships.

The Mission Involvement Services (MIS) department, led by Brian Nester, sends out teams of students, faculty and staff during Christmas and Spring Break and during the summer all around the world for short term mission trips.

The Touring Teams departments use drama and music to communicate Biblical truth and support local churches throughout the United States. Master's Puppets 1 and 2 and Lifeline Players are the three drama teams led by Brandon Waltz. Heartsong has three music teams led by Jim Cato. These teams tour on weekends throughout the school year and nine weeks during the summer.

Another part of Christian Ministries is Cedarville University Fellowship. Fellowship is a student run service held each Sunday night at 6pm in the chapel by the Advisory 7 (AD7). The AD7 is a group of men chosen by the student body near the end of the fall semester. These seven men are responsible for helping Pastor Rohm organize Fellowship.

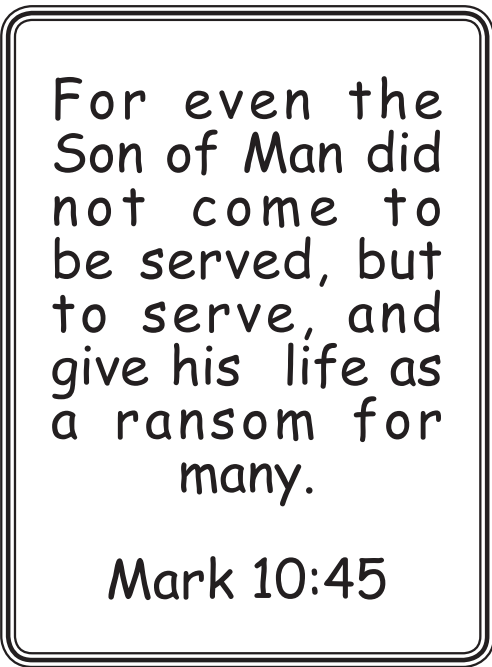
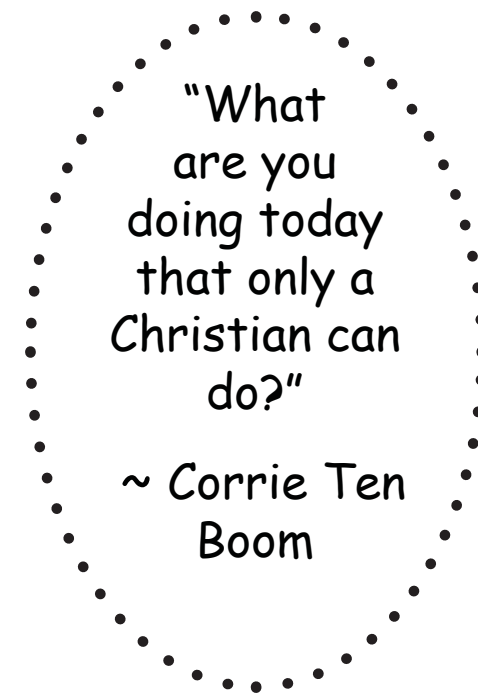
