We all know Cedarville has three music touring teams called HeartSong, but few of us realize Cedarville also has three drama teams - Master's Puppets 1 & 2 and Lifeline Players. Each team seeks to use drama as a powerful tool in communicating biblical truth in a unique and relevant way. Brandon Waltz, director of all three drama teams, said the most rewarding thing for him is seeing God at work in the lives of the team members.

Master's Puppets' ministers mainly to children through puppet shows and VBS, while Lifeline Players seeks to minister to teens and adults through dramatic sketches. Matt Deakin, a Master's Puppets member, said his favorite week this summer was spent at Camp Echoing Hills, a camp for children with disabilities. "The kids were awesome. I had the privilege of leading Cameron to the Lord the second or third day of camp. It was the best week of my summer." Through Master's Puppets, "you learn so much about serving others - your hosts and the kids." Each team member has amazing stories to tell about how God worked in their life and in others. To really get a good picture of what drama teams are all about, talk to them and listen to their stories. Auditions for Lifeline Players are held at the end of spring semester, while Master's Puppet auditions are held Getting Started Weekend.
