



Ministry Grant Application–Continuing Students

This grant ranges from \$400–\$2,200 and is offered to continuing students beginning at Cedarville University prior to fall 2010 who have a parent employed in full-time vocational ministry (pastors, missionaries, Christian educators, etc.).

Any student who meets the Ministry Grant criteria will receive the basic \$400 Ministry Grant; FAFSA is not required. Students who complete the FAFSA will undergo a need assessment to determine their grant amount. Need is determined after FAFSA EFC and other institutional, state, and federal grants/scholarships are applied.

A cumulative Cedarville GPA of 2.5 or above is required for renewal. The Ministry Grant can be combined with Academic as well as the Legacy Grant. The Ministry Grant cannot be awarded for students receiving full-tuition remission benefits.
