WHO

WHAT

This outstanding soccer academy offers solid instruction in the fundamental skills and tactical strategies of the game of soccer. Daily competitions, drills, and one-on-one attention build individual skills and team performance. Time is also set aside each day to consider Christian principles and their application to daily living. Coach Ben Belleman serves as the camp director. He is assisted by current and former Cedarville soccer players and qualified coaches.

WHEN

July 11–15, 2010

Check in between 2–4 p.m. on Sunday in the Doden Field House. The first camp session begins at 5 p.m. Camp concludes at 12 p.m. on Thursday.

WHERE

Cedarville University, Cedarville, Ohio

Practices are held in Cedarville's outstanding training and match facilities, including the lighted stadium soccer complex and multiple practice fields.

Students will be housed in air-conditioned residence halls on campus. There will be counselor supervision throughout the residence halls; campers will be housed according to age category. Campers need to bring their own bedding and towels. Campers are responsible for lost keys (\$50) and any room damage.

All-you-can-eat meals will be provided in the University dining hall.

COST

\$315 per resident camper
\$220 per commuter

Fee includes T-shirt as well as room and board for a resident camper and lunch and supper for a commuter.

CAMP DIRECTOR: BEN BELLEMAN

Coach Ben Belleman completed his ninth season this past fall as head coach of the Cedarville University men's soccer team and has a 106-69-16 record. He has led the Yellow Jackets to the NAIA playoffs four of his nine seasons and advanced to the NCCAA national tournament four times. The Yellow Jackets have earned the prestigious Sportsmanship Award at the NCCAA National Tournament three times and the coveted American Midwest Conference Fair Play Team Award on two occasions. Belleman is a four-time NCCAA Midwest Region Coach of the Year and was tabbed the American Midwest Conference South Division



Coach of the Year in 2005, the same year he was inducted into the OSSCA Hall of Fame.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: WHAT RESIDENCE HALL SUPERVISION IS PROVIDED?

A: Team coaches and camp staff will provide supervision in the residence halls. Camper/staff ratio is approximately 10 to 1.

Q: HOW MANY STUDENTS ARE IN EACH RESIDENCE HALL ROOM?

A: There will be two students per room. Campers are in their rooms only overnight.

Q: WHO RECEIVES THE EARLY REGISTRATION DISCOUNT?

A: Campers who register three weeks prior to camp qualify for a discount of \$10 per player. (See website for details.)

Q: WHAT MEALS ARE PROVIDED?

A: Resident campers receive three meals per day beginning with dinner on Sunday and ending with breakfast on Thursday. Commuter campers receive lunch and dinner Monday–Wednesday.

Q: ARE CAMPERS BUSY ALL DAY?

A: The schedule for camps is rigorous but includes time for relaxation and relationship-building. A typical day begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 9 p.m. See the schedule at www.cedarville.edu/sportscamps.

Q: MAY CAMPERS BRING ELECTRONIC GAMES, IPODS, CELL PHONES, OR OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES?

A: Students are discouraged from bringing electronic devices. The University is not responsible for lost, broken, or stolen items.

Q: MAY A STUDENT CALL HOME?

A: A phone will be available in the lobby of each residence hall. Phone cards are needed for long distance.

Q: MAY STUDENTS LEAVE CAMP FOR OTHER SUMMER SPORTS ACTIVITIES?

A: Yes, with approval of the coach and parent.

Q: MAY PARENTS OBSERVE CAMP?

A: Yes, parents are welcome to watch games. Schedules are provided at the start of camp.

Q: SHOULD CAMPERS BRING MONEY?

A: A camp bank will be available on registration day. All money should be put into the camp bank. A concession stand is provided each day for snacks.
