A typical freshman who begins in the fall semester will receive a 1098-T for that calendar year (not academic year) reflecting the amounts paid for fall semester (box 1) and financial aid (box 5).

For the next calendar year, the student will receive a 1098-T which reflects the spring semester's AND the next fall semester's payments and financial aid.
