

## 2020 Summer Ireland Information Sheet CU Study Abroad

### Courses offered:

Dr. Melissa Faulkner and Professor Cyndi Messer will be leading the program.  
LIT-2300 Introduction to Literature (3 hours) – meets Humanities gen. ed. requirement  
Special Topics: Travel Writing

Students will have the opportunity to earn credits for general education requirements while touring Ireland and visiting locations including Galway, Cliffs of Moher, and Belfast. Other excursions that enhance the courses will be planned by the professor.

### Dates:

May 6 – 28, 2020

### Registration:

Complete a Study Abroad application and health screening and send to Study Abroad by January 15, 2020.

### Proposed Schedule:

May 6	Fly to Dublin
May 7	Take a bus to Galway, orientation, walking tour of the city
May 8	Excursion to Cliffs of Moher
May 9	Brunch at An Tobar Nua, Christian Café/ministry, then bus to Dublin and arrive at Greystones
May 10-13	Courses at Coolnagreina in Greystones
May 14	Excursion to Belfast, Giant's Causeway
May 15-26	Remainder of program in Greystones
May 27	Farewell dinner at Hillside Church
May 28	Return to the U.S.

Remember that you are a guest in this culture, so you need to be aware of their customs. These websites offer cultural information:

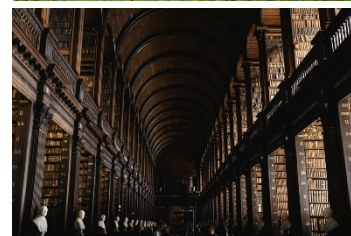

Non-refundable fee – due Jan. 20	\$ 200
Program fee	\$1750
Tuition (times the number of hours)	\$ 831 per credit hour
Administrative fee	\$ 250

**Other expenses:** books, immunizations (see the Center for Disease Control for suggested immunizations), international insurance, passport, some meals. During the stay at Coolnagreina, meals



are provided during the week. Weekends are open for students to travel in groups with the permission of the professor. Meals are not provided on the weekends.

\*Note that financial aid and scholarships do not typically apply in the summer.

**Billing:**

You will register for your Study Abroad courses through our office. Typically you will see the charges for summer courses on your bill about mid-April. The charges will include the tuition (based on your course registration), the program fee, and the administrative fee.

### How does billing work?

Your student account will be charged the program fee, administrative fee, and tuition about April 15. Additional charges apply for credits over 17 for the Summer Term. Airfare is not included in these calculations.

Example:	\$ 1,750	program fee
	\$ 200	non-refundable fee
	\$ 2,493	3 hours times Summer tuition
	+ \$ 250	administrative fee
	\$ 4,693	amount owed
