

## 2020 Summer National Parks Information Sheet CU Study Abroad

### Dates: May 5 – 20, 2020\*

Students must arrive at Denver Stapleton airport by late morning on Tuesday, May 5<sup>th</sup>, and cannot leave from Denver Stapleton airport before late evening on Wednesday, May 20<sup>th</sup>.



**Registration:** Complete the Study Abroad application and health screening. Bring to the Study Abroad office by January 15. After the first ten applications, registrants will be put on a wait list.

### Proposed Schedule and Destination:

Yellowstone National Park, the Grand Tetons National Park, Jackson’s Hole area, Dinosaur National Monument, Badlands National Park, Rocky Mountains National Park, Devils Tower National Monument, Big Horn Mountains National Recreation Area, Scotts Bluff National Monument, Mt. Rushmore National Monument, the Black Hills (Custer State Park) and many other places – historic, cultural, and national sites. NOTE: There will be a lot of hiking so participants should be used to walking long distances over various terrain.



### Tips:

This is a physically rigorous course. It is advised that students prepare themselves by exercising the previous semester.

<b>Tuition</b> - \$831 per credit hour (3.5 hours)	\$ 2,908.50	_____
<b>Spending money</b> – typically \$300 – \$1000, but depends on the student and the amount of traveling done	\$ 100	_____
<b>Food</b> – most meals included but bring \$30 per day for snacks, etc.	\$ 450	_____
<b>Airfare</b> – each student books on their own and meets at assigned city	\$ 500	_____

### How does billing work?

Your student account will be charged the program fee, administrative fee, and tuition about April 15. Additional charges apply for credits over 17 for the Summer Term. Airfare is not included in these calculations.

Example:

\$ 1,750	program fee
\$ 200	non-refundable fee
+ <u>\$ 2,908.50</u>	3.5 hours times Summer tuition (\$831 per credit hour)
\$4,858.50	total amount owed to CU

**I understand that, if my student account is not current or I owe a balance from a previous term, I will not be eligible to register for a CU Abroad program. It is my responsibility to meet with Financial Aid regarding my scholarships and grants.**
