Housing:

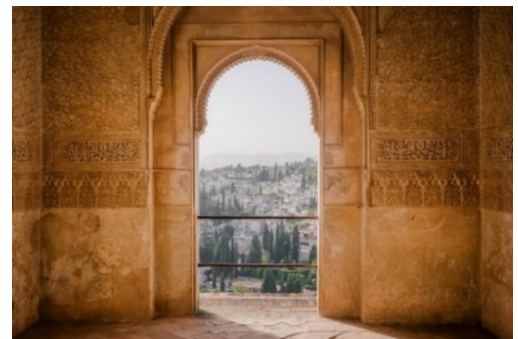
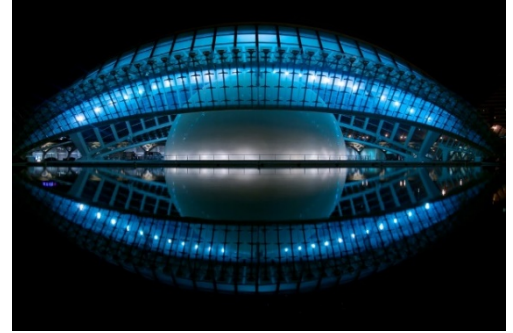
