Please make sure you **sign in** so we have a concrete record for your grade. You may also count off-campus classical or jazz recitals or concerts (college level or above). Bring your ticket stubs or programs to the office as verification of your attendance.

Make sure you register for Recital and Program Attendance (GMUS 1030 01) or else going to these events will count for nothing. If an event is duplicated (eg. Bach's Literacy Series, Jazz Band), you may only claim it one time.
