# Step 1 – CedarNet Username and Password

## Welcome to Computing at Cedarville!

If you are visiting as part of a camp or conference, your host may assign a temporary CedarNet username and password to you during check-in (e.g., username: TEMP3000, password: wezvuy).

With these login credentials, you can access the Internet using any University-owned computer. You can also use the credentials to access Cedarville's wireless network using your laptop.

**Parents** can obtain a CedarNet username and password when their student runs a "Parent Access" transaction through CedarInfo. Note that the <u>primary</u> purpose of parent access is to grant parent access to student financial and transcript information.

# Step 2 – Connect Your Self–Provided Computer (SPC)

This guide refers to a laptop brought from home as an SPC (self-provided computer). The following instructions will assist you in getting your SPC connected to CedarNet (the network).

#### Wired Connection

If you are staying in the residence halls, each dorm room has two network ports available for your use.

To access CedarNet using a wired connection, **attach** a CAT5 (or CAT6) Ethernet patch/network cable to the network port on your SPC, and then **insert** the cable into the active network port in the wall.

Physical ports are always "on," so once you have plugged in the network cable you will be connected to CedarNet. **Log in** using the temporary username and password that you were assigned.

## Wireless Connection

The following table illustrates the wireless options that are available during your visit to Cedarville University.

## CU - Unsecure Network

- 1. Enable wireless on your SPC and connect to the cu-unsecure wireless network.
- 2. Open an Internet browser (e.g., Internet Explorer or Safari) and enter your temporary **username** and **password** when prompted.
- 3. You may need to log in a second time at the "Cedarville University Internet Access Login" screen.
- 4. If you are using Internet Explorer, click Continue to this Website. You should be all set!
